THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me JOHN HEMINGWAY of 36 Saint
Kevin's Park Upper Rathmines in the County of Dublin hereby revoking all former
wills made heretofore by me I bequeath to Miss Fanny McMurray of Belfast the sum of
five hundred pounds I give devise and bequeath all the rest residue and remainder
of my property and effects of every kind real and personal unto my daughter Eva
Hemingway and Harold Normington of St Kevin's Park aforesaid Upon trust to permit my
wife Eliza Hemingway to use occupy and enjoy the house and premises No 36 St Kevin's
Park aforesaid now occupied by me together with the furniture and effects of every
kind in or about the same for the term of her life and subject thereto shall hold
the said furniture and effects in trust for my said daughter Eva Hemingway absolute-
ly and shall hold the said house and premises and all the rest residue and remainder
of my property and effects of every kind upon trust for all my children in equal
shares as tenants in common absolutely subject to the payment of an annuity of one
hundred and fifty six pounds to my said wife for the term of her life such annuity
to be paid by equal payments of three pounds each week and to be charged upon and
payable out of all my property I direct that my daughter Ida Booth shall give credit
against her share of the residuary property for the sum of one thousand two hundred
pounds which I recently advanced to her for the purchase of a house in Princess
Royal Terrace Scarborough and my trustees and executors shall charge her share with
said sum accordingly I appoint my said daughter Eva Hemingway and the said Harold
Normington EXECUTORS of this my Will IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand
